Assessment of Administrators Committee Meeting

Minutes:

- 1. The last assessment was conducted S19, so we are currently behind. An assessment should have been conducted S22.
- 2. SACS COC Standard 5.4 mandates the regular assessment of administrators; this standard is met through the annual performance review process. The college-wide assessment of administrators constitutes a secondary method of assessment and should be conducted on a three-year cycle.
- 3. Key Questions: How often should the assessment be conducted? Should it be an annual process? The most recently used IOTA form consists of sixteen questions on a rating scale of 0-4. The assessment should be conducted on an annual basis since it is a short questionnaire and provides an opportunity for both accountability and self-improvement.
- 4. Timing: The assessment should be conducted in the spring and become an ordinary part of campus culture.
- 5. The comments section should be retained because it allows potentially for the most valuable feedback.
- 6. Scheduling: The assessment will be conducted S23 with a window of availability of approximately one month. The assessment will be synchronized with student course evaluations, which open 1 April. An announcement of the upcoming assessment should be made at the spring convocation.
- 7. Tasks to be completed before the next meeting: Review the assessment instrument -- both questions and guidelines. Also review the description of the committee found on jWeb.
- 8. Next meeting: 4 Friday, November, at 9:00 AM, in the Foundation Board Room. This will be an in-person meeting with Zoom availability.
- 9. Sharing of results: Aggregated data should be available campus-wide. Comments should be redacted.
