- Meeting:
 - Goals for athletic department are being set
 - Improve social media presence, including the athletic jscc website
 - Social media is being controlled by head softball coach, Taylor Moore
 - Athletic Website may be controlled by head women's basketball coach, Kelvin Lester
 - In order to update website, need to have actual access to it/full control
 - Looking to switch to Presto Sports, but need to see when/if this can be afforded.
 - 2018-2019 graduation/transfer information:
 - TCCAA Academic Awards
 - 6 of our baseball and softball **freshmen** awarded
 - 1 women's basketball, 6 softball, and 7 baseball **sophomores** awarded
 - Transfers: calculated by taking total # of sophomores that finished the season
 - 100 % transfer rate of all sophomores across the 4 sports
 - "Transfer" = calculated by taking total # of sophomores that finished the season and enrolled in a 4 year college or selective admissions program the following Fall year (ex: nursing)
 - Graduation:
 - 70.6% graduation rate within the 4 sports (combining all sophomores and those who graduated)
 - Numbers can fluctuate depending on how many sophomores are eligible in a given season.
 - 72% were male
 - 68.7% were female
 - Summer compliance training occurred to serve as refreshers department.
 - Team updates:
 - Taylor Moore took the head softball coaching position in October of 2019
 - Recently had her first win on 02/09/2020.
 - Coach Hines recently had his 300th win within Men's Basketball
 - Men's Basketball are tied for 1st in conference as of today
 - Women's Basketball may be tied for 4th in the conference as of today
 - Basketball tournament is at the end of this month in Columbia.

- Softball and Baseball had several reschedules and cancellations due to weather
 - Conference games will begin at the end of the month.
- Department updates:
 - Travis Livingston, the athletic trainer, is not JSCC's full-time, as this would be contingent on adding another sport
 - Adding another sport will be put on hold in order to monitor and maintain the sports we currently have on campus.
- A concern was raised about athletes struggling with the new digital books.
 - This was found not to be a concern/issue within the teams.
- Summaries of each sport regarding budgets (salaries, expenditures), assistant coaches, full-time coaches were discussed.

 - Jen said she would bring this up with Steve.
