The committee met, reviewed, and discussed the following proposals.

The VPAA asked the committee to reconsider the first agenda item, embed or add COL 1030 to all TTPs, and emailed the faculty prior to the meeting with information concerning the QEP, QEP timeline, the TBR 60+3 approval, and other pieces of information that he felt had bearing on the course and this proposal. Prior to the meeting, members on the committee spoke with faculty in their respective area of representation to garner feedback on this proposal. A motion was made and seconded to approve this item. A vote was taken with three members in favor, four opposed, and two abstained—the motion failed.

The other three agenda items were all unanimously approved.

1. Embed or add COL 1030 to all TTPs

I recommend that the college move forward with adding an embedding COL 1030 to all TTP's beginning fall 2017. LB

2. Course description change HIST 2030 proposed: A study of the prehistory period of Tennessee, including a general survey of the various Indian groups. Emphasis will be placed on the early European explorations in the transmontane country. Early attempts by Tennesseans to establish independent governments will be examined. The Jacksonian period from 1815 through 1848 will be a central theme, and a study of the national and state events of the 1850s that led to the Civil War will be included. In addition, a detailed examination of the Civil War, Reconstruction, the 1870 State Constitution, WWI, Progressivism, the New Deal, WWII, the Cold War, and modern Tennessee will be conducted.


Based upon 4/10/17 meeting with Dr. Bailey to review topic, I support Dr. Bailey's recommendation. JSCC will review

4. New TTP: Physical Education


