- 1. <u>Change in AST degree requirement</u>: Reduce second Social/Behavioral Science requirement to POLS 1030 American Government ONLY. (currently students may choose from POLS 1030, POLS 2025, SOCI 1010, or SOCI 1020). This change is occurring due to TBR alignment of the AST degree. *To be effective Fall 2021 if approved.*
- <u>Correction in Number and Course description for HIMT 1401 to HIMT 1304</u>: The wrong number for the course was proposed originally. HIMT 1401 Disease Processes should be HIMT 1304 (per TBR course inventory—HIMT 1401 is actually a 4 credit hour course by the same name). There is also a slight change in the course description per TBR course inventory. The correct description should be: Description: This course is an introduction to disease processes in the human body with emphasis on the etiology, signs, symptoms, diagnostic aids and findings, and treatment, including medications. *To be effective Spring 2021*.
