- **Screening updates:**
 - Language on the screening question, “Have you had a fever in the last 48 hours?” is being updated to “Have you had a fever in the last 24 hours? (without fever reducing medication)”.
 - Language on the screening question, “Have you been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID 19 or tested positive for COVID 19?” is being updated to “Have you been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID 19 or tested positive for COVID 19 within the past 14 days?”.
 - A new report has been written for COVID screening. A system administrator can add a faculty or staff member to a building. The faculty and/or staff can run the report by date for the building and will be given a list of those that have completed the form and if they are cleared or not cleared to be on campus for that date.
