Flu Vaccine

There are some fears that flu season will be more dangerous this year due to people being home last year and subsequently not being exposed to the more current flu antibodies. The flu vaccine will be available during the drive-thru benefits fair outside the gym. HR staff are currently finalizing those dates. It is usually held during the last week in September or the first week in October to coincide with open enrollment.

COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic

The Covid vaccine clinic on campus will be Sept. 28 and 29 for the first shot and Oct. 20 and 21 for the second dose. The booster shot will not be offered during this clinic, as The Lift is hosting our event. These boosters are only authorized (as of today) through the state health departments. JMCGH will know by Friday if/when they will have access to the booster.
