- **Access Priority 1:** JSCC will increase participation levels of the diverse communities in its service area with particular attention given to underrepresented minorities, underserved populations, and other targeted subpopulations.

- ✓ **Access Goal 1.1:** JSCC will increase overall enrollment (**Headcount**) and FTE for fall and spring semesters.

- ✓ **Metric:** Student Counts (THEC beginning-of-term data file)

- ✓ **Data Source(s):** 14th Day Census File

- ✓ **Initiatives:** TBR Strategic Plan (SP); THEC Outcomes Progression; reorganization of Admissions recruitment area; implementing JSCC Enrollment Management Plan; Expanded academic program offerings (e.g. AAS Respiratory Care); expanded sites of instructions (e.g. Paris); TN Promise; TN Reconnect; addition of physical buildings on main campus (Health Sciences and Nursing); addition of new and emerging technologies (e.g. radiography equipment, nursing simulators, science labs); TN Promise Forward grant (e.g. Kathy Fisher); Increasing dual credit initiative, examining potential graduate data, conversion of dual enrollment students, what programs do students attend?, using Programs of Excellence as attraction, engagement opportunities-athletics, clubs, TN Promise, increased enrollment opportunities at off-campus centers, providing full “college experience” on campus, putting dollars behind student engagement, options or choices for events, clubs, food service, athletics, etc.

- ✓ **Opportunities:** e-rate for bordering counties; expansion of JSCC out-of-state service area; online degree offering(s)

- ✓ **Access Goal 1.2:** JSCC will increase the enrollment and FTE of targeted subpopulation

- ✓ **Targeted Subpopulations:** Promise Adults, Veterans, Healthcare, Dual Enrollment, and Military

5	Community College Survey of Student Engagement	A survey for college students (not including dual enrollment) who are taking classes on campus to gauge engagement in and out of the classroom. The survey provides JSCC with information about the student experience that is not captured elsewhere.	Every other academic year	spring terms	Institutional Research	Key Findings are shared with campus as a whole. Specific pieces of data are shared with various groups on campus who are focused on different subgroups of students.	CCSSE is used as part of the Quality Assurance Funding report, and it is scored using JSCC's previous scores as well as CCSSE's overall data. This survey provides JSCC with information on the student experience that we cannot/do not get elsewhere. The data can be broken down into very specific subsets in order to really view the experience of a particular type of student.
