

NURSING BUILDING NORTH PARKWAY VIEW









Tennessee Promise

Enrollment Fluctuations

- FTE Decrease of -3.8 for Fall 2013
- FTE Decrease of -13.3% for Fall 2012
- FTE Decrease of -4.3% for Fall 2011
- FTE Increase of 2.8% for Fall 2010
- FTE Increase of 18.2% for Fall 2009
