






# Average Cost of Attendance per Year 2010-2011

# Average Amount of Financial Aid By Type 2008-2009










#### Time to Graduation for Students Taking Developmental Studies Courses 2010 Graduates Total DSP Graduates = 299




### IPEDS "Student Right to Know" Graduation and Transfer-Out Rates Fall 2006 Cohort


# Students Who Graduated or Transferred Out Within 150% of Normal Time to Completion




#### Students Who Graduated Within 150% of Normal Time by Gender
