

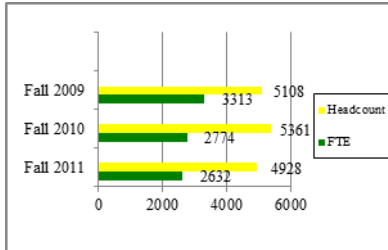

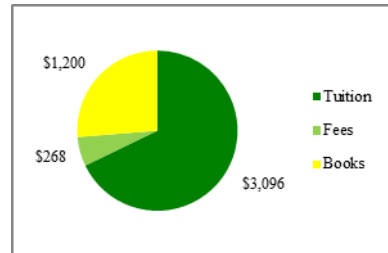

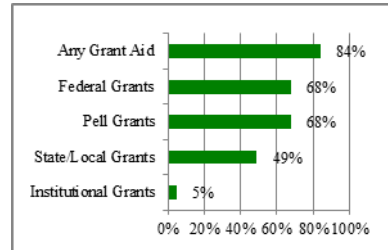

Cost of Attendance and Financial Aid

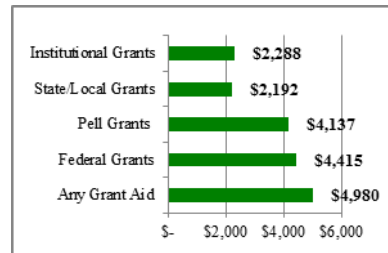
Average Cost of Attendance per Year

2009-2010

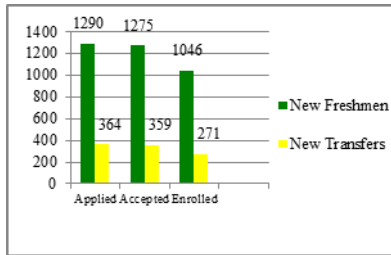

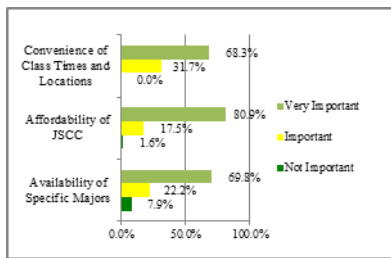

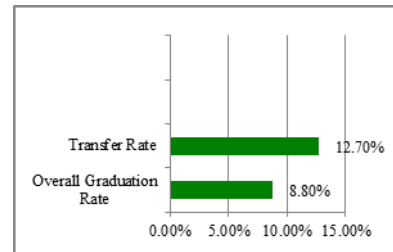

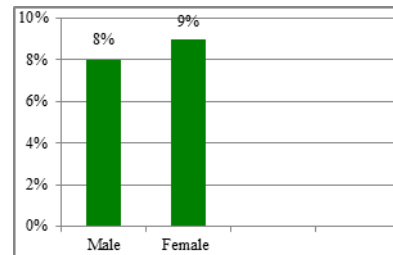
**IPEDS “Student Right to Know” Graduation and

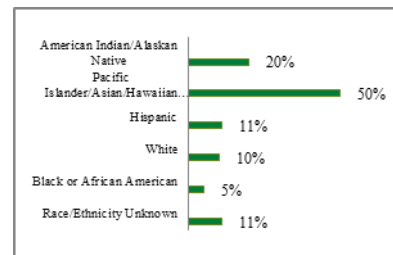
**Students Who Graduated or Transferred Out
