






# **Degree Credit Enrollment by Attendance Status**

#### **Fall Full-Time Enrollment**






#### **Fall Percentage Enrollment**






# **Degree Credit Enrollment by Gender**

#### **Fall Female Enrollment**








# **Non-Traditional Adult Enrollment (Degree Credit)**






# First-Time Freshmen Enrollment (Degree Credit)

# **Average ACT Composite Score**






# **Student Enrollment in Asynchronous Learning**

# **Fall Regents Online Degree Program Enrollment (Degree Credit)**











#### **Fall-To-Fall Retention (Full-Time Freshmen\*)**





### Three-Year Rate\* (IPEDS)




